**WAGE SCHEDULE 'A'**

**INPLANT WORKERS**

- \$1.00 per hour contribution to the Pension Fund for Lead A workers only.
- \$0.50 per hour contribution to the Pension Fund except Lead A.
- \$7.06 per hour contribution to the Health & Welfare Fund.
- \$0.07 cents per hour contribution to the Industry Fund.
- \$0.29 cents per hour contribution to the Apprenticeship Fund.
- \$0.05 cents per hour contribution to FTI Fund.
- \$0.05 cents per hour contribution to LMP Fund.
- 7.6% per hour vacation/holiday deduction will be made in accordance with ARTICLE IX.
- The company may award merit increases at any time the Employer feels such employee's work warrants an increase, but under no circumstances shall an employee be advanced less than one production classification per each six (6) months from date of hire.
