

Member policy for welding reimbursement

Effective 6/10/2010 the Joint Apprentices Training Committee enacted the following policy

You must be a member of Glassworkers local 740 and be in good standing.

The Glaziers Joint Apprenticeship Training Committee will reimburse up to 12 credit hrs or 192 contact hours not to exceed 1400.00, also allow up to 125.00 reimbursement for tools consisting of 1 leather jacket, 1 welding hood, 1 wire brush, 1 slag hammer and 1 pair of welding gloves.

The JATC will also reimburse the member for the passing lab test fee only.

One of 2 certifications will be accepted. Certification in (FCAW all position v groove 1/8" to 1") or (FCAW all position fillet weld 1/8" to unlimited) certification in any other processes must be approved by the committee prior to taking welding courses.

Committee will reimburse from these institutions, Clackamas Community College, Mt Hood Community College, (including tuition paid at our facility), Portland Community College, Clark College, Chemekita Community College and Lane Community College.

Lab reimbursements will be made from these Labs, Carlton Testing or PSI. Other welding institutions and Labs must be approved by the committee before member enrolls.

All receipts for reimbursement must be submitted to the training coordinator within 30 days of certification, this includes reimbursement for renewal cards.
